New release targets readers who want more

Ventura, California—July 2010—Nordskog Publishing releases Loving God with All Your Heart: Keeping the Greatest Commandment in Everyday Life, a Christian living title by Susie Hobson answering the age-old question of “What am I missing in life?” Nordskog describes Loving God with All Your Heart as a “meaty, tasty, and easily digestible Biblical treasure.”

Loving God with All Your Heart: Keeping the Greatest Commandment in Everyday Life by author Susie Hobson speaks to the deepest, albeit most misunderstood longing of the human heart: the desire to be in an intimate relationship with the Almighty.

Says Hobson: “I hear the same the statement over and over: ‘Susie, I want more.’ There is a desire for something which people, places, possessions, fame, and fortune cannot fill. I am convinced that something is a real and powerful relationship with God. And God wants this, too.”

Drawing from her own personal experiences with disarming honesty, Hobson articulates major barriers that must be overcome to achieve true intimacy with God: How can I love an unseen Creator? How can I love someone I cannot touch or hug? If I love God with all my heart, am I talking about a major time obligation? A lifetime commitment?

Hobson identifies many problems within the modern church, such as the fifty-percent divorce rate among churchgoers, as caused by a “de-powered” relationship with God. “I have found that many people, despite years of church attendance and belief in God, feel God is way off in heaven and we are way down here, and so settle for a kind of ‘wave-at-your-neighbor-down-the-street’ type of relationship with Him.” Further, Hobson believes some church leaders are negligent in encouraging people to practice spiritual disciplines, such as Bible reading, on the pretext that it would drive down church attendance.

Hobson boldly outlines a clear roadmap leading from an casual acquaintance with God to “a great relationship” with Him, which functions by God hearing from us and we hearing from God.

“Susie Hobson’s *Loving God with All Your Heart* is practical, powerful, and applicable” said Babbie Mason, recording artist and songwriter. “I believe God will use this book to create an unquenchable thirst that can only be satisfied by an intimate relationship with Him.”
